Students are required to commit to their registered riding activities for a minimum of one term and must give 30 days written notice of intent to withdraw at the end of the first term if this is their intention.

Refunds are not made unless a medical situation results in a significant amount of time absent. This must be discussed with the Equestrian Director and backed with a medical certificate. Make up lessons may be available for lessons canceled for school-organized functions, check with your coach or the Program Director.

\*\* Groom Service (Partial) – Feeding, watering, stall cleaning.

\*\*\* Groom Service (Full) – Feeding, watering, stall cleaning, show prep, walking and lunging.
