Queen Margaret's "Home for the Weekend" Boarders have independence within a small and safe living environment, structured academic support, friends from around the world, and the ability to be close to their family and friends when they return on the weekends.

Our five-day boarders travel home to the Lower Mainland, Fraser Valley, Sunshine Coast and Northern Vancouver Island using school-provided bussing to Nanaimo or one of the Nanaimo ferry terminals serving Vancouver & Tsawwassen.

There are a small number of "Red Weekend" events when all boarders are required to remain in Residence to enjoy the festivities.

Our "Home for the Weekend" boarders are also welcome to stay in Residence for additional weekends to participate in field trips, dances and other activities at an extra per diem charge that includes meals.
